ORDER ON FORMER HUSBAND'S MOTION FOR PROTECTIVE ORDER

THIS CAUSE came before the Court for hearing upon Former Husband's Motion for Protective Order filed by Respondent, Brian Harris Saluck ("Former Husband"). Petitioner, Robyn Stephanie Greenberg ("Former Wife"), Former Husband, and Former Husband's counsel were present at the hearing. The Court having reviewed the file, the Motion, heard testimony, and being otherwise advised in the premises, hereby FINDS as follows:

1. On July 12, 2017, Former Wife propounded her Additional Interrogatories to Former Husband wherein she sought specific information related to Former Husband's health.
2. On August 29, 2017, Former Husband filed his Objection to Former Wife's Additional Interrogatories to Former Husband alleging that the information sought was not relevant in assisting this Court in its determination of the pending issues.
3. On August 29, 2017 Former Wife filed her Motion to Compel and Former Husband correspondingly filed his Motion for Protective Order on September 5, 2017.
4. Confidentiality of the court records in the above-styled dissolution of marriage file is required in order to protect Former Husband from incurring substantial injury due to his

livelihood being irreparably harmed by information if information regarding Former Husband's health is disclosed to third parties.

5. Neither party's name is determined to be confidential.

6. The progress docket or similar records generated to document activity in this case are not determined to be confidential.

7. Any and all information relating to Former Husband's health is determined to be confidential.

8. The degree, duration, and manner of confidentiality ordered by this Court are no broader than necessary to protect Former Husband's interests.

9. Less restrictive measures are not available to protect Former Husband's interests.

THEREFORE, in consideration of the above findings, the Court hereby ORDERS AND ADJUDGES as follows:

A. Due to the stipulations reached by the parties at the hearing, Former Wife's Motion to Compel is GRANTED; and

B. Any and all information relating to Former Husband's health is designated confidential;

C. All court records in the parties' above-styled dissolution of marriage action shall be sealed until agreement of the parties or further Court order;

D. Both parties and their respective present and future counsel, if applicable, are permitted to view the confidential information;

E. The Clerk of Court shall publish this Order in accordance with rule 2.420(e)(4), Florida Rules of Judicial Administration; and

F. Former Wife and her present and future counsel are prohibited from disclosing any and all information learned in the course of the above-captioned litigation to third parties.
