**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO DETERMINE
CONFIDENTIALITY OF COURT RECORDS**

THIS MATTER came before the Court on the Petitioner and Respondent's Motion to Determine Confidentiality of Court Records pursuant to Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.420(c)(9)(A)(v)-(vi). The Court finds:

1. The records of concern are the following:
 - A. Final Judgment
 - B. Marital Settlement Agreement
 - C. Income Withholding Order
 - D. Florida Addendum to Income Withholding Order
 - E. Memorandum to the Clerk
2. The release of these documents could lead to substantial injury to an innocent party and to parties regarding privacy matters generally protected under common law.
3. There is no less restrictive measure available to protect these interests, and the degree, duration and manner of confidentiality ordered herein are no broader than necessary to protect these interests.

It is THEREFORE ORDERED:


- A. The Motion to Determine Confidentiality of Court Records is GRANTED.
- B. The Final Judgment, Marital Settlement Agreement, Income Withholding Order,

Order Granting Motion to Determine Confidentiality of Court Records

Florida Addendum to Income Withholding Order, and Memorandum to the Clerk shall be confidential records.

- C. Except for those persons named in any subsequent Court Order, the following are the only persons to have access and inspection rights of the documents under seal:
1. The parties herein.
 2. The law firms representing each party in this dissolution of marriage action.
 3. The Clerk of the Circuit Court and employees of such department in fulfillment of their duties.
 4. Members of the Judiciary.
- D. The Clerk is directed accordingly.
