**ORDER ON DEFENDANTS' MOTION TO DETERMINE CONFIDENTIALITY OF
COURT RECORDS**

THIS CAUSE having come before the Court on Defendants' Motion to Determine Confidentiality of Court Records, and the Court having reviewed the Motion and being fully advised in the premises, it is:

ORDERED that

1. The Court finds the information on pages 171-291 of Defendants' Motion to Determine Confidentiality of Court Records is confidential pursuant to rule 2.420(c)(7) Fla. R. Gen. Prac. & Jud. Admin.; and
2. Those records shall be treated as confidential under rule 2.420; and
3. The entities permitted to view the confidential information are this Court, the parties in this case, and the representatives and experts for the parties; and
4. The materials shall be confidential for the remainder of this action; and

5. The degree, duration, and manner of confidentiality ordered by this Court are no broader than necessary to protect the interests set forth above; and
6. There are no less restrictive measures available to protect the interests set forth above; and
7. The clerk of court is directed to (a) designate as confidential the materials identified in paragraph 1 above and (b) publish this order in accordance with rule 2.420(e)(4).
